Appointment Booking

To book or cancel appointments please call the practice and speak to the reception team. Alternatively you can use SystmOnline, which is an online system where you can manage your appointments, and view your records. Enhanced Summary Care Records

The NHS *Summary Care Record* (SCR) is an electronic summary of key clinical information (including medicines, allergies and adverse reactions) about a patient, sourced from the GP record. It is used by authorised healthcare professionals, with the patient's consent, to support their care and treatment.

Fill in a consent form at your surgery so additional information can be added and you can decide what you would like healthcare professionals to see. It may be that you are a carer or have specific needs regarding your long term health condition.

Care Navigation

Receptionists and clerical staff are now trained to help patients by identifying the most appropriate place or health clinician for your care.

Care navigation is about getting you the right advice and the right service. This is often quicker than waiting to see the GP and staff may even be able to advise of another service which could see you straightaway. Working in this way helps to free up time for GPs to care for patients with complex or serious health conditions that can only be managed by the GP. More importantly though, it means people are first seen by the clinician that is best placed to manage their clinical problem.

Services Available

The following services are offered by the practice, though some may require a referral from a GP and appointments may be made at an alternative surgery.

- Physiotherapy
- Ante-natal clinic
- Chronic disease management clinics
- Family planning
- Well Woman clinic
- NHS Health checks
- Medical examinations (non– NHS)
- Minor Surgery Clinic
- Retinal Screening (Eye examination)
- Counselling Services

Online Consultation

The Practice also offers an online consultation service. You can save time and don't need to travel to the practice to receive medical advice. You can simply input your symptoms online and receive a response from the practice. Typically, you will receive a response the same day if your request is received between 06:30 and 14:00.

The online service also gives you access to the reliable self-help generic information portal 24 hours a day.

Polite Notice

If you have an appointment that you no longer require or can no longer attend. Please ensure that you can cancel it by contacting the practice or using SystmOnline, which is your Practices online system.

Each missed appointment costs the NHS around £30 and missed appointments in our area cost the taxpayer a total of £121,980 per month.

More importantly, waiting times are being badly affected by 'no shows', meaning some people are unable to get an appointment due to people not cancelling when they should.
